S 1250. ONLINE VEHICLE REGISTRATION PARTNERSHIPS. Filed 3/21/07. TO PROVIDE AN ONLINE DEALER PROCESS FOR THE REGISTRATION AND TITLING OF MOTOR VEHICLES, TO ESTABLISH FEES FOR SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE THIRD-PARTY ELECTRONIC SYSTEM REGISTRATION AND TITLING SERVICE PROVIDERS, AND TO PROVIDE FOR FEES TO THE STATE AND COMMISSION CONTRACT OFFICES THAT PROVIDE QUALITY ASSURANCE CHECKS FOR DEALERS THAT HAVE A CONTRACT AND WHO USE THE THIRD-PARTY ELECTRONIC SYSTEM REGISTRATION AND TITLING SERVICE PROVIDER.

Amends GS 20-63 to exclude the Charlotte office of the Division of Motor Vehicles (DMV) from the provision in subsection (h) regarding commission contracts for issuance of plates and certificates. Amends subsection (i) to authorize acceptance of financial transaction card payments for any fees and penalties. New subsection (j) authorizes the DMV to enter into contracts with third-party electronic system providers for the remote electronic filing of documentation for new certificates of title, registration plates, or registration cards. New subsection (j1) requires licensed motor vehicle dealers that conduct more than 50 transactions per calendar month for the processing of an application for a new certificate of title or registration to use a third-party electronic system provider for the remote electronic filing of documentation. Other dealers may use such systems. New subsections establish a \$15 fee for certain manual transactions by licensed motor vehicle dealers and a \$12 fee for certain purchasers.
