S 1331. MODIFY BEDDING SANITATION LAWS. Filed 3/21/07. TO EXTEND THE LAWS GOVERNING SANITATION OF BEDDING TO SLEEP PRODUCTS AND SECONDHAND FURNISHINGS AND TO MAKE CLARIFYING, CONFORMING, AND TECHNICAL AMENDMENTS TO THOSE LAWS.

Amends various provisions in Part 8 of Article 8 of GS Chapter 130A, renaming the part "Sleep Products and Secondhand Furnishings." Changes the term *bedding* to *sleep products* and adds a definition of *home furnishings*, but does not otherwise regulate or affect home furnishings. Provides that unsanitized secondhand furniture may not be stored in the same building with newer sanitized sleep products. Amends provisions on sanitizing sleep products, material used in the manufacture of sleep products, storage of unsanitized used materials, tagging of sleep products, altering tags, sleep products sale regulation, registration numbers, licensing, and exemptions. Makes conforming changes. Effective December 1, 2007.
