**S 1432. CHALLENGE TO ADMINISTRATIVE SUBPOENA.** Filed 3/21/07. *TO ALLOW FOR A MEANINGFUL CHALLENGE TO AN ADMINISTRATIVE SUBPOENA.*

Amends GS 96-4 dealing with proceedings before the Employment Security Commission, GS 105-290 dealing with appeals to the Property Tax Commission, and GS 150B-39 of the Administrative Procedures Act, to clarify the procedure for making a motion to quash a subpoena issued by a commission and to provide for review of a denial of a motion to quash by the Superior Court in Wake County or in the Superior Court in the county where the person subject to the subpoena resides.
