S 1452. DIESEL SCHOOL BUSES TO USE MINIMUM B-20 FUEL. Filed 3/21/07. *TO REQUIRE PUBLIC SCHOOL BUSES OR OTHER VEHICLES FOR STUDENT TRANSPORTATION THAT ARE CAPABLE OF OPERATING ON DIESEL FUEL TO BE CAPABLE OF OPERATING ON DIESEL FUEL WITH A MINIMUM BIODIESEL CONCENTRATION OF B-20.*

Amends various provisions in GS Chapter 115C as title indicates. Effective January 1, 2009, and applies to vehicles transferred or purchased on or after that date.

S 1452. DIESEL SCHOOL BUSES TO USE MINIMUM B-20 FUEL. Filed 3/21/07. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Modifies GS 115C-249(a) to require that at least 2% of the fuel purchased annually by local school districts statewide for use in school bus diesel engines be a biodiesel fuel with a minimum blend of B-20 (as defined in GS 143-58.4) to the extent that the biodiesel blend is available and compatible with technology of the equipment being used. Changes the effective date to June 1, 2008 (was, January 1, 2009).

S 1452. DIESEL SCHOOL BUSES TO USE MINIMUM B-20 FUEL. Filed 3/21/07. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 2nd edition. Modifies proposed changes to GS 115C-253 to remove all substantive changes. Deletes the proposed changes to GS 115C-238.29F9(h), which would have required vehicles used by charter schools to provide transportation to students that can operate on diesel fuel to be able to operate on diesel fuel with a minimum biodiesel concentration of B-20. Makes technical section numbering changes.
