**S 1456. TANDEM VEHICLE OPERATIONS ON HIGHWAYS.** Filed 3/22/07. *TO ALLOW TANDEM VEHICLE COMBINATIONS TO OPERATE ON ALL HIGHWAYS WITHIN THE STATE.*

Amends GS 20-115.1(b) as title indicates. Statute had exempted only highways designated federal aid primary system highways by the US Secretary of Transportation as well as those subject to other exemptions by the US Secretary of Transportation.

**S 1456. TANDEM VEHICLE OPERATIONS ON HIGHWAYS.** Filed 3/22/07. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Changes title to *AN ACT TO ALLOW CERTAIN TANDEM VEHICLE COMBINATIONS TO OPERATE ON HIGHWAYS WITHIN THE STATE.* Amends GS 20-116 (size of vehicles and loads) subsection (e), adding a provision stating that motor vehicle combinations of one semitrailer of not more than 48 feet in length and a truck tractor (power unit) may exceed the 60 feet maximum length. Amends GS 20-115.1 (limitations on tandem trailers and semitrailers on certain NC highways) subsections (f) and (g), adding a provision to each subsection stating that the Department of Transportation may approve reasonable access routes for one particular type of STAA-dimensional vehicle when significant, substantial differences in their operating characteristics exist.
