S 1462. STUDY OF K-12 SCHOOL GOVERNANCE. Filed 3/22/07. *TO ESTABLISH THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE STUDY COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC SCHOOL GOVERNANCE.*

Creates the Joint Legislative Study Committee on Public School Governance (Committee) to study issues related to public school governance and to consider the advisability of more closely aligning the governance system of K-12 with that of the University of North Carolina and the Community College System. Provides guidelines for the selection of Committee members, powers granted to the Committee, and other operational aspects of the Committee. Requires the Committee to report its findings and recommendations, including any legislative recommendations, to the 2008 regular session of the 2007 General Assembly, and provides that the Committee terminates upon filing its report. Directs the Legislative Services Commission to allocate funds from those appropriated to the General Assembly for the expenses of the Committee.
