S 156. SESSION LIMITS. Filed 2/13/07. *TO AMEND THE NORTH CAROLINA CONSTITUTION TO LIMIT THE LENGTH OF LEGISLATIVE SESSIONS.* Requires a referendum during the next statewide primary or general election on proposed amendments to Article II of the NC Constitution limiting long sessions of the General Assembly to 135 calendar days and short sessions to 60 calendar days, beginning with the 2009 regular session. Provides that sessions may be extended by joint resolution for up to 10 days. Excludes from the limits any reconvened sessions called by the Governor.
