**S 173. NO RESIDENCY/DISABLED HUNTING LICENSE.** Filed 2/13/07. *TO REMOVE THE RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT ON ALL HUNTING AND FISHING LICENSES FOR THE DISABLED AND TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS*. Amends various sections of GS Chapter 113 as title indicates. Amends GS 113-270.1A(a1) to clarify that a person who qualifies for any hunting or fishing license for the disabled need not produce a certificate of competency from an approved hunter safety course in order to receive the license, as long as the person does not use the license unless accompanied by a licensed adult who maintains proximity to and monitors the activities of the disabled hunter. Effective July 1, 2007.

S 173. SWINE FARM ENV. PERFORMANCE STANDARDS/FUNDS (NEW). Filed 2/13/07. Senate committee substitute deletes all provisions of 1st edition and replaces it with AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE SWINE FARM WASTE MANAGEMENT SYSTEM CONVERSION ACCOUNT. Contingent on Section 2 of S 1465 (establishing the lagoon conversion program) being enacted into law, appropriates \$10 million for 2007-08 and \$10 million for 2008-09 from the General Fund to the Swine Farm Waste Management System Conversion Account within the Division of Soil and Water Conservation of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources for various purposes itemized in the act. States that it is the intent of the General Assembly that the appropriation be recurring. Effective July 1, 2007.
