S 193. GASTON AND LINCOLN BOUNDARIES. Filed 2/15/07. *TO ASSIST GASTON AND LINCOLN COUNTIES IN RESOLVING THEIR COMMON BOUNDARY BY ALLOWING THEM TO VARY FROM THE LINE ESTABLISHED BY THE 1963 GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO RECOGNIZE HISTORICAL PRACTICE.* Amends Section 1 of Chapter 596 of the 1963 Session Law to allow Gaston and Lincoln Counties to establish the line between the counties in accordance with GS 153A-18 (uncertain or disputed boundary) and respecting the currently observed boundary line as much as possible. Until the line has been established, the line will be considered as it has been in practice.
