S 2122. CAMPUS POLICE FOR PRIVATE SCHOOLS/DURHAM CO. Filed 5/28/08. *TO PROVIDE CAMPUS POLICE FOR A PRIVATE ELEMENTARY, MIDDLE, OR HIGH SCHOOL IN DURHAM COUNTY.*

Enacts GS 115C-47.1 to allow private schools in Durham County to establish campus law enforcement agencies and employ campus police officers as title indicates. Delineates the officers' jurisdiction. Allows schools that establish a law enforcement agency to enter into joint agreements with local governments for an extension of jurisdiction.

S 2122. CAMPUS POLICE FOR PRIVATE SCHOOLS/DURHAM CO. Filed 5/28/08. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Amends proposed GS 115C-47.1 to specify that a private elementary, middle, or high school may establish a campus law enforcement agency and employ campus police officers. Provides that officers must meet the requirements of Chapter 74G of the General Statutes. Officers' territorial jurisdiction includes all property owned by or leased to the school employing the officers. Defines *private school* as a qualified nonpublic school under GS 115C-555. Deletes provision allowing schools with campus police to enter into agreements with municipalities to extend the officers' authority into the municipality. Amends GS 132-1.4(b)(3) to include campus police within the definition of "public law enforcement agency." Provides that the bill takes effect when it becomes law.
