S 226. WILMINGTON CIVILIAN TRAFFIC INVESTIGATORS (NEW). Filed 2/20/07. Senate committee substitute deletes the provisions of the 1st edition and replaces it with *AN ACT TO ALLOW THE CITY OF WILMINGTON TO USE CIVILIAN TRAFFIC INVESTIGATORS TO INVESTIGATE PROPERTY DAMAGE CRASHES*. Authorizes the City of Wilmington to employ civilians as Civilian Traffic Investigators (CTI) to investigate traffic crashes involving only property damage. Requires Wilmington to establish minimum standards for employment. Requires CTIs to attend a training program and spend no less than four weeks in field training. Requires Wilmington to issue credentials identifying individuals as CTIs, which must be produced when requested by individuals involved in or witnessing a crash. Prohibits vehicles issued to or used by a CTI from having marking identifying the vehicle as a police vehicle. Requires a CTI to comply with GS 20-166.1 (reports and investigations required in event of accident). Establishes other powers that CTIs do and do not have. Requires the City of Wilmington to give a written report on the training and use of CTIs from the effective date of the act through November 1, 2008, to listed House and Senate committees by December 31, 2008.
