S 32. AMEND DV LAWS/HOMICIDE REPORTING. Filed 1/29/07. *TO AMEND CRIMINAL PROCEDURE LAWS AFFECTING DOMESTIC VIOLENCE VICTIMS AND TO REQUIRE DOMESTIC VIOLENCE HOMICIDE REPORTING AS RECOMMENDED BY THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE ON DOMESTIC VIOLENCE.* GS 15A-401(b)(2) authorizes an officer to arrest a person without a warrant for certain offenses committed outside the presence of the officer if the officer has probable cause to believe the person committed the offense. Section 1 extends the statute to cover the misdemeanor offenses of communicating threats (GS 14-277.1) and stalking (GS 14-277.3) if the offense is committed by a person with whom the victim has a personal relationship as defined in GS 50B-1. Section 2 amends GS 15A-534.1 to add stalking to the list of charging offenses for which the judicial official who determines the conditions of pretrial release must be a judge. Section 3 requires the Attorney General's Office to compile statistics and report annually on homicides in which the offender and the victim had a personal relationship. Sections 1 and 2 become effective for offenses committed on or after December 1, 2007.
