S 353. PRESIDENTIAL ELECTORS BY DISTRICT. Filed 2/26/07. TO PROVIDE FOR THE ELECTION OF TWO PRESIDENTIAL ELECTORS AT LARGE AND ONE FROM EACH CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT.

Enacts new GS 163-208.1 (Representation) providing that one elector must be chosen from each congressional district and two electors must be chosen from the state at large. Amends GS 163-209 to require each party and unaffiliated candidate to nominate one candidate for elector for each congressional district and two candidates at large; electors are the slate of electors receiving the highest number of votes for President and Vice President statewide and in a congressional district. Amends GS 163-210 to require electors at large to cast their ballots for presidential and vice-presidential candidates receiving the most votes in the state and electors for each congressional district to cast ballots for presidential and vice-presidential candidates receiving the most votes in that district.
