Changes the title to *AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE BENTONVILLE BATTLEFIELD FUND IN THE DIVISION OF STATE HISTORIC SITES AND CONFORMING THE LAWS GOVERNING NORTH CAROLINA AQUARIUMS FUND, THE* TRYON PALACE HISTORIC SITES AND GARDENS FUND, AND SPECIAL REGISTRATION *PLATES TO THE STATE BUDGET ACT*.
