S 371. USE OF SENATE SEALS AND COAT OF ARMS. Filed 2/27/07. TO PROHIBIT COMMERCIAL USE OF LIKENESSES OF ANY SEAL OR COAT OF ARMS OF THE SENATE.

Enacts new GS 120-271 making it a Class 2 misdemeanor to knowingly use, manufacture, reproduce, sell, or purchase for resale any likeness of any seal or coat of arms of the Senate, except as directed by the Senate or the Principal Clerk of the Senate or for manufacture or sale of an article for official use of the state. The Attorney General may bring suit to enjoin a violation of the section.
