S 375. MOTORCYCLE LEARNER'S PERMIT. Filed 2/27/07. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Changes title to AN ACT TO SHORTEN THE DURATION AND AMEND THE REQUIREMENTS FOR A MOTORCYCLE LEARNER'S PERMIT, AND CLARIFY THE REQUIREMENTS FOR OBTAINING A MOTORCYCLE ENDORSEMENT.

Reorganizes GS 20-7(a1) and amends its provisions regarding the license requirements to drive a motorcycle and obtaining a motorcycle endorsement. Amends GS 20-7(a2) to specify how applicants less than 18 years of age and applicants who have held a valid driver's license for less than two years may obtain a motorcycle learner's permit. Restores previous fee provision for a motorcycle learner's permit, which had been amended by prior edition.
