**S 383. WAKE SCHOOL BOARD ELECTIONS.** Filed 2/27/07. TO PROVIDE FOR ELECTION OF MEMBERS OF THE WAKE COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION AT-LARGE, AND TO MOVE THOSE ELECTIONS TO THE EVEN-NUMBERED YEAR, TO BE ELECTED IN NOVEMBER ON A PLURALITY BASIS.

Amends Section 7 of SL 1975-717, as amended, to provide that members of the Wake County Board of Education are to be elected at large and by the plurality method instead of the current election and runoff method. Amends Section 6 of SL 1975-717, as amended, to require that four members of the Wake County Board of Education are elected in 2010 and five members are elected in 2008. Extends terms of office expiring in 2007 and 2009 to December of the following year. Makes conforming change by repealing Section 5 of SL 1975-717 and requires replacements for vacancies for terms expiring in 2008 and 2010 to reside in the same district from which the vacating member was elected.
