Further amends the Brevard Charter to require that vacancies in the office of mayor and in the office of councilman be filled in accordance with GS 160A-63 (by appointment of the city council). Makes a conforming change concerning the length of the mayor's term. Amends the effective date to provide that the provision concerning the filling of vacancies is effective when it becomes law and the remainder of the act is effective January 1, 2009, and applies to mayoral elections conducted after January 1, 2009. Makes conforming title change.
