Filed 3/5/07. *EXEMPTING POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS OF THE STATE FROM THE LAWS REGULATING PUBLIC CONTRACTS WHEN PURCHASING FROM CONTRACTS ESTABLISHED BY THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA OR ANY FEDERAL AGENCY.* Enacts GS 143-129(e)(9a) exempting from provisions regarding procedures for public contracts the purchase of apparatus, supplies, materials, or equipment from contracts established by a federal agency if the contractor is willing to extend the same or more favorable prices, terms, and conditions to a political subdivision.
