Appropriates \$3.5 million for 2007-08 and \$1.6 million for 2008-09 from the General Fund to the UNC Board of Governors as title indicates. \$1.9 million of the allocation for 2007-08 is to be used for infrastructure and equipment, and \$1.6 million is to be used for recurring operational expenses in each fiscal year.

Appropriates \$1.2 million for 2007-08 and \$1.2 million for 2008-09 from the General Fund to the UNC Board of Governors for allocation to North Carolina State University, North Carolina Agricultural Research Service, to support research to improve the feeding value of ethanol, and biodiesel by-products and alternative feed sources.

Appropriates \$700,000 for 2007-08 and \$700,000 for 2008-09 from the General Fund to the UNC Board of Governors for allocation to North Carolina State University for a center that will focus on new technologies for efficient and clean use of traditional energy sources and on alternative energy sources.
