S 60. DMV TEMPORARY LOCATIONS. Filed 2/5/07. *TO REQUIRE THE DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO IMMEDIATELY DESIGNATE A TEMPORARY LOCATION FOR REGISTRATION DOCUMENT AND PLATE ACQUISITION WHEN CLOSING THE ONLY CONTRACT LICENSE PLATE AGENCY IN A COUNTY.* Enacts GS 20-63 (h2) to require that when the only agency location in a county is closed, the Division of Motor Vehicles must immediately designate a new location for issuing vehicle plates, registration, and certificates of title. Also requires that the new location's address and phone number be posted at the old location for at least 30 days, and makes failure of a former contract agent to allow this posting a Class 3 misdemeanor.

S 60. DMV TEMPORARY LOCATIONS. Filed 2/5/07. Senate amendment makes the following changes to 1st edition. Requires the Division of Motor Vehicles to designate a temporary location for issuing plates, registration certificates, and certificates of title as soon as practicable (was, immediately). Also requires counties with an existing drivers license office that can accommodate additional vehicle services staff to open the temporary location within 30 days. Does not conform title.
