**S 749. LONG-TERM CARE PROVIDERS/CRIM. HISTORY STUDY.** Filed 3/13/07. *TO DIRECT THE NORTH CAROLINA STUDY COMMISSION ON AGING TO STUDY THE NECESSITY FOR LIMITING THE AUTHORITY OF LONG-TERM CARE PROVIDERS IN HIRING CONVICTED FELONS.*

Directs the North Carolina Study Commission on Aging (commission), in consultation with the Department of Health and Human Services, the North Carolina Attorney General's office, and long-term care provider associations and advocacy groups to study the authority of a nursing home, home care agency, adult care home, or its contract agency to determine if there is a need to specify certain convictions that would automatically disqualify an applicant for employment. Requires the commission to submit its findings to the General Assembly.
