**S 749. LONG-TERM CARE PROVIDERS/CRIM. HISTORY STUDY.** Filed 3/13/07. TO DIRECT THE NORTH CAROLINA STUDY COMMISSION ON AGING TO STUDY THE NECESSITY FOR LIMITING THE AUTHORITY OF LONG-TERM CARE PROVIDERS IN HIRING CONVICTED FELONS.

Directs the North Carolina Study Commission on Aging (commission), in consultation with the Department of Health and Human Services, the North Carolina Attorney General's office, and long-term care provider associations and advocacy groups to study the authority of a nursing home, home care agency, adult care home, or its contract agency to determine if there is a need to specify certain convictions that would automatically disqualify an applicant for employment. Requires the commission to submit its findings to the General Assembly.
