S 767. TERM LIMITS FOR CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICERS. Filed 3/14/07. AMENDING THE CONSTITUTION TO LIMIT THE TERMS OF THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE OF THE SENATE TO TWO CONSECUTIVE GENERAL ASSEMBLIES.

Subject to approval by the voters at the November 2008 general election, amends Sections 15 and 14 of Article II of the North Carolina Constitution to limit the terms a person can serve as Speaker of the House of Representatives or as President Pro Tempore of the Senate to two consecutive General Assemblies. If approved by the voters, the amendments will become effective upon the convening of General Assembly next on or after January 1, 2009.
