Provides for an amendment to Section 10, Article IV of the North Carolina Constitution extending the term of district court judges from four to eight years to be submitted to the voters at the statewide general election in November 2008. Conditional upon approval of the amendment, the act also amends GS 7A-140 and GS 163-1 to reflect the change in term of office to eight years.
