Filed 3/19/07. *TO REVISE THE LAW GRANTING AUTHORITY TO PRIVATE CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS EMPLOYED PURSUANT TO A CONTRACT WITH THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF PRISONS.* Amends GS 148-37.3, which regulates the use of private correctional officers who are employed in a private prison operated in North Carolina under contract with the federal prison system, to eliminate all requirements that the Department of Correction (DOC) regulate the private contractor's practices, including approving employment policies for the private contractor and certifying that the contractor's training program complies with state standards. In place of those requirements, the bill authorizes the state Department of Justice to adopt rules to ensure that the contractor's employment practices and training program are equivalent to the DOC's. S 930. PRIVATE CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS. Filed 3/19/07. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Revises GS 148-37.3 to (1) delete the requirement that a private corporation employing correctional officers and supervisors provide a certificate of insurance evidencing compliance with the insurance requirements of GS 148-37.3(d); (2) delete the provision requiring the adoption of rules to implement GS 148-37.3; and (3) provide that when a state agency provides services to a private corporation employing correctional officers and supervisors, the corporation bears the costs of the services and the amount of the costs is determined by the head of the state agency that provided the services.
