S 982. IMMUNIZATION CERTIFICATE/COLLEGE STUDENTS. Filed 3/19/07. *PERTAINING TO THE REQUIREMENT FOR AN IMMUNIZATION CERTIFICATE FROM CERTAIN COLLEGE STUDENTS.*

Amends GS 130A-155.1 to include students taking a combination of night or weekend courses and no more than four credit hours during the day and residing off campus in those persons not required to provide an immunization certificate in order to attend college.

S 982. IMMUNIZATION CERTIFICATE/COLLEGE STUDENTS. Filed 3/19/07. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Clarifies that a record of immunization must be presented on or before the day a person first registers for more than four credit hours during the day (was, for more than four credit hours).

S 982. IMMUNIZATION CERTIFICATE/COLLEGE STUDENTS. Filed 3/19/07. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 2nd edition. Replaces the term *person* with *student* throughout the bill. Moves the exclusions to new subsection (e) and excludes students residing off-campus and taking any combination of the listed categories of courses (was, excludes students (1) registered only in off-campus courses, (2) attending only night or weekend classes, (3) taking four credit hours or less and residing off campus, or (4) taking a combination of night or weekend classes and no more than four hours during the day and residing off campus). Makes technical changes.
