H 1062. AMEND RULE/RESORT SPAS/RECORDS RETENTION. Filed 4/2/09. LIMITING THE AMOUNT OF TIME A RESORT SPA OFFERING MASSAGE AND BODYWORK THERAPY IS REQUIRED TO MAINTAIN CLIENT RECORDS UNDER THE NORTH CAROLINA MASSAGE AND BODYWORK THERAPY PRACTICE ACT.

Enacts new GS 90-637 requiring a licensee of a resort spa (defined as a spa that is promoted as an on-property amenity for a lodging facility that has on-premise dining, shopping, and meeting space) that provides massage and bodywork therapy for recreational purposes to maintain a client's file for at least six months after providing the massage and bodywork therapy. Requires that the spa store and dispose of a client's records in a secure and confidential manner. Intro. by Goforth.
