Amends GS 157-9.1 to apply the use of the term *low income* when it appears in GS Chapter 157, as being construed to mean *low and moderate income*, to all cities with a population of more than 12,000 according to the most recent decennial federal census and to all counties with a population of more than 40,000 according to the most recent decennial federal census.

Modifies proposed GS 157-9.1(e) to clarify that the use of the term *low income* to mean *low and moderate income* applies to (1) housing authorities of all cities that have a population of less than 20,000 (was, more than 12,000) and are the location of a constituent institution of UNC that has a student enrollment of more than 10,000 students and (2) housing authorities of all counties that have a population of less than 80,000 (was, 40,000) and are the location of a constituent institution of UNC that has a student enrollment of more than 10,000 students.
