H 1205. ESTABLISH NC COMMISSION ON CLIMATE CHANGE. Filed 4/7/09. TO ESTABLISH THE NORTH CAROLINA COMMISSION ON CLIMATE CHANGE AND TO ESTABLISH THE ADVISORY COUNCIL TO THE NORTH CAROLINA COMMISSION ON CLIMATE CHANGE.

Adds new Article 12Q to Chapter 120 of the General Statutes, establishing a North Carolina Commission on Climate Change. The Commission's 15 members are either legislators or appointees of the Governor. Requires the Commission to study "issues related to global climate change," including legal, economic, and technological issues, and must make appropriate reports and recommendations. The bill also establishes a 20-member Advisory Council to the Commission, consisting of business leaders, academics, and leaders of nonprofit environmental organizations, or their designees. It may assist the Commission as requested.
