Adds GS 20-4.01(27)i. to define a medium-speed vehicle to mean a self-propelled electrically powered four-wheeled motor vehicle equipped with a roll bar or crush-resistant body design, which can attain a speed of 30 miles per hour but less than 35 miles per hour in one mile. Amends GS 20-121.1 to make numerous conforming changes to treat medium-speed vehicles like "low-speed vehicles" for purposes of applicable speed limits, equipment standards, registration, and insurance.
