TO AMEND THE LAW REGARDING LIABILITY OF A COMMERCIAL SOCIAL NETWORKING SITE TO PROVIDE THAT THE WEB SITE SHALL NOT BE HELD CIVILLY LIABLE FOR DAMAGES ARISING OUT OF COMMUNICATIONS ON THE WEB SITE IF THE WEB SITE MAKES A GOOD FAITH ATTEMPT TO SCREEN OUT USERS WHO ARE IN THE STATEWIDE SEX OFFENDER REGISTRY.

Amends GS 14-202.5A, apparently to provide that a commercial social networking site that complies with GS 14-208.15A or makes other reasonable efforts to prevent a registered sex offender from accessing its Website cannot be held civilly liable for damages arising out of any person's communications on the Website. Effective December 1, 2009.
