H 1336. AMEND IRRIGATION CONTRACTORS' LICENSING LAWS. Filed 4/8/09. AMENDING THE LAWS REGULATING IRRIGATION CONTRACTORS TO PROVIDE SUBSTANTIVE REQUIREMENTS FOR LICENSING CORPORATIONS, TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF LICENSES TO NONRESIDENTS, TO CLARIFY THE FEE STRUCTURE, AND TO MAKE OTHER CONFORMING CHANGES.

Amends GS 89G-3, GS 89G-9(b), GS 89G-10(a), and GS 89G-11 as the title indicates. Enacts GS 89G-6.1 providing for when the Board may issue a license in the name of a corporation, limited liability company, or partnership, and in an assumed or designated trade name. Also enacts GS 89G-6.2 concerning the licensing of nonresidents.

H 1336. AMEND IRRIGATION CONTRACTORS' LICENSING LAWS. Filed 4/8/09. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Amends GS 89G-3 (providing exemptions to the provisions of GS Chapter 89, *Irrigation Contractors*) to clarify that the exemption applies to a licensed general contractor who is classified under GS 87-10(b) as a building contractor, a residential contractor, or a public utilities contractor. Limits a public utilities contractor exempted under this section to performing only the activities described in GS 87-10(b)(3)a. Rewrites proposed GS 89G-6.1 to clarify that when an individual licensee, other than a sole proprietor, executes a contract for irrigation construction on behalf of another person, the person on whose behalf the licensee is executing the contract must be licensed under this section. Also adds limited liability companies (LLCs) to those entities doing business under an assumed or designated trade name that are required to notify the NC Irrigation Contractors' Licensing Board (Board) in accordance with rules adopted by the Board if an individual licensee ceases to be affiliated with the LLC.

Changes the effective date to October 1, 2009 (was, effective when the act becomes law).
