H 1405. STUDY/AFTER-SCHOOL CHILD CARE PROGRAMS. Filed 04/09/09. AUTHORIZING A JOINT LEGISLATIVE STUDY COMMISSION ON AFTER-SCHOOL CHILD CARE AND RELATED PROGRAMS AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THAT PURPOSE.

Creates 12-member commission to study shortfalls and benefits of after-school child care and related programs and consider adjustments, consolidations and reprioritization of funds to maximize the benefit to the states' children and families and consider how after-school child care affects economic development. The commission is to report to the 2010 Regular Session of the 2009 General Assembly. Appropriates \$25,000 for 2009-10 from the General Fund to the General Assembly to fund the work of the commission. Effective July 1, 2009.
