Amends GS 113-337 to make it a Class 1 misdemeanor to capture, injure, or kill a bat, disturb a bat in its roost, deliberately disturb a group of bats, or intentionally obstruct access to a bat roost. Exempts authorized bat exclusion actions performed by a certified wildlife control agent. Effective December 1, 2009, and applies to acts committed on or after that date.
