H 1422. UNC TUITION SURCHARGE EXEMPTION. Filed 4/9/09. TO CREATE A LIMITED EXCEPTION TO THE POLICY OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA THAT REQUIRES THAT A TUITION SURCHARGE BE IMPOSED ON ANY UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT WHO EXCEEDS THE LIMIT OF ONE HUNDRED FORTY CREDIT HOURS.

Amends Section 89(b) of SL 1993-321, as amended, to authorize the UNC Board of Governors to establish a policy that provides for an exemption to the tuition surcharge for students who demonstrate military deployment, serious medical debilitation, or other extraordinary hardship that has substantially disrupted or interrupted the pursuit of a degree.
