H 1446. AMEND LAW RE: SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLANS. Filed 04/9/09. TO AMEND THE LAW RELATING TO SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLANS.

Amends GS 115C-47(38) by requiring the composition of school improvement teams to comply with GS 115C-105.27(a), which requires that school improvement teams consist of the principal of each school, representatives of the assistant principals, instructional personnel, instructional support personnel, and teacher assistants assigned to the school building and parents of children enrolled in the school with the parents reflecting the racial and socioeconomic composition of the students enrolled at that school. Amends GS 115C-105.27(a) by requiring that the goals set out in the mission statement for the public schools adopted by the State Board of Education (SBE) be taken into consideration in setting the annual performance goal for a school, and requiring that all school improvement plans be data-driven to the greatest extent possible, analyzing student data to identify root causes for problems and to determine actions to address them, and containing clear, unambiguous targets, explicit indicators and actual measures, as well as speedy time frames for improvement. Amends subsection (e) by reducing the length of time a school improvement plan shall remain in effect from three years to two years. Amends GS 115C-105.37A(a) by adding the requirement that the school improvement plan for a low performing school must be reviewed and approved by the SBE. Applies beginning with the 2009-2010 school year.
