STATE MAINTENANCE VEHICLES-PARKING CAPITOL.** Filed 4/9/09. *TO ALLOW STATE MAINTENANCE VEHICLES TO PARK IN METERED PARKING SPACES NEAR THE CAPITOL GROUNDS AND TO PROHIBIT PARKING OF MAINTENANCE VEHICLES ON THE STATE CAPITOL GROUNDS IN A MANNER THAT OBSTRUCTS THE VIEW OF OR ACCESS TO MONUMENTS.*

Enacts GS 143-345.10 as the title indicates.

**H 1453. STATE MAINTENANCE VEHICLES—PARKING CAPITOL.** Filed 4/9/09. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Specifies that maintenance service vehicles of General Services Division may park at any metered parking space without charge at any space adjacent to (was, located at or near) Capitol Square *when performing work on Capitol Square.*

**H 1453. STATE MAINTENANCE VEHICLES-PARKING CAPITOL.** Filed 4/9/09. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 2nd edition. Amends proposed GS 143-345.10 to provide that maintenance vehicles of the Department of Administration (was, General Services Division) may park *without charge* at any metered parking space located on the street blocks bordering (was, immediately adjacent to) the State's Capital Square when performing work at or on the Capital Square. Makes conforming changes to the statute's caption and the act's title.
