H 1480. STUDY EXPAND PERMITTED 911 FUND USES (NEW). Filed 4/9/09. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Deletes amendment to GS 62A-46 which expanded the permitted uses of 911 funds by Public Safety Answering Points (PSAPs) in the state. Instead, creates the House Select Committee on the Use of 911 Funds to study the use of the 911 Funds by PSAPs. Provides for eight members to be appointed by the Speaker of the House. Provides issues that the Committee may consider in its study and guidelines for the operation of the Committee. Directs the Committee to submit a final report to the 2009 General Assembly, Regular Session 2010 and provides that the Committee may submit interim reports as it deems necessary. Directs the Committee to terminate upon the filing of its final report or upon the convening of the 2010 General Assembly, whichever comes first. Makes a conforming change to the title.
