H 1482. UNC GRADUATION INCENTIVE ACT. Filed 4/9/09. *TO PROVIDE AN INCENTIVE FOR STUDENTS IN THE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM TO GRADUATE ON TIME.*

Adds new GS 116-143.7 requiring the UNC Board of Governors to ensure that procedures are established to impose a 100% tuition surcharge on students who take more than 140 degree credit hours to complete a four-year program or more than 110% of the credit hours necessary to complete a five-year program. Does not apply to those who complete the degree in the designated four- or five-year period, advanced placement credits, or credits from summer term or extension programs.
