H 1496. STUDY BEACON HR/PAYROLL IMPLEMENTATION. Filed 4/9/09. CREATING THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE STUDY COMMISSION ON IMPLEMENTATION OF THE BEACON HR/PAYROLL SYSTEM AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THAT PURPOSE.

Creates the 16-member Joint Legislative Study Commission on BEACON HR/Payroll System Implementation. The Speaker of the House and President Pro Tempore of the Senate each appoint eight members and designate co-chairs. Specifies member qualifications and provides that the State Chief Information Officer or designee is to be a non-voting ex officio member. Specifies content of the study and requires an interim report to the 2010 session of the General Assembly and a final report and recommendations to the 2011 General Assembly. Commission terminates upon filing final report. Appropriates from the General Fund \$50,000 in 2009-10 and \$50,000 in 2010-11 to the General Assembly to fund the work of the Commission. Effective July 1, 2009.
