H 1620. STUDY LEG. TUITION GRANT/CAREER COLLEGES. Filed 5/6/09. TO ESTABLISH THE LEGISLATIVE TUITION GRANT STUDY COMMISSION TO DETERMINE THE IMPACT AND BENEFIT OF MAKING THE LEGISLATIVE TUITION GRANTS AVAILABLE TO ELIGIBLE STUDENTS WHO ATTEND NORTH CAROLINA CAREER COLLEGES AND SCHOOLS.

As the title indicates. Commission will consist of three members of the House of Representatives (appointed by the Speaker), three Senators (appointed by the President Pro Tem), and two persons associated with a North Carolina career college or school (one appointed by the Speaker and one by the President Pro Tem). The Commission is authorized to make an interim report to the General Assembly's 2010 regular session and required to submit a final report and recommendations to the 2011 General Assembly. Effective July 1, 2009.
