H 1676. SUBSTITUTE TEACHER UNEMPLOYMENT. Filed 5/12/10. TO RESTORE A BALANCE TO THE LAW ON UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION FOR SUBSTITUTE TEACHERS AS RECOMMENDED BY THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE EDUCATION OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE.

Amends GS 96-8(10) to define a *full-time substitute* as a substitute employee who works (1) more than 30 hours a week, (2) on a continual basis, (3) for a period of six months or more. Provides that no substitute teacher or other substitute school personnel seeking unemployment benefits is to be considered unemployed for days or weeks when the individual is not called to work unless the individual was employed as a full-time substitute during the period for which the unemployment benefits are being requested.
