As title indicates. Requires that the agency perform the following in the study: (1) identify positions that warrant a criminal history record check (check); (2) develop a process for conducting the check; (3) designate the entities responsible for requesting and for paying for the check; (4) determine whether a State, a national, or both checks are performed; and (5) define the offenses that indicate an individual's fitness to be responsible for program participants' safety and well-being. Requires that the agency report to the North Carolina Study Commission on Aging all findings and recommendations by November 1, 2010.
