H 1710. FISHERY MANAGEMENT PLAN SUPPLEMENTS. Filed 5/13/10. TO PROVIDE AN EXPEDITED PROCESS BY WHICH THE MARINE FISHERIES COMMISSION MAY SUPPLEMENT FISHERY MANAGEMENT PLANS, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE COMMISSION ON SEAFOOD AND AQUACULTURE.

Amends GS 113-182.1, as title indicates, to allow the Secretary of Environment and Natural Resources to authorize the Marine Fisheries Commission (Commission) to develop temporary measures to supplement an existing Fishery Management Plan (FMP). Allows the Commission to adopt the supplementary measures under the North Carolina Administrative Procedure Act (GS Chapter 150B). Exempts the supplementary measures from GS 113-182.1(c) (requiring an FMP advisory committee), GS 113-182.1(c1) (requiring review of the FMP with regional advisory committees), and GS 113-182.1(e) (reporting requirements for FMPs). Also exempts the supplementary measures from the Commission's Priority List, Schedule, and guidance criteria, as provided under GS 143B-289.52. Provides that the Commission will either incorporate the supplementary measures into the revised FMP at the next FMP review period, or the measures will expire when the revised FMP is adopted.

Amends GS 113-182.1(e1) to clarify that the Secretary of Environment and Natural Resources may authorize the Marine Fisheries Commission (Commission) to develop temporary *management* measures (was, temporary measures or temporary supplementary measures) under subsection (e1). Deletes the requirement that the Commission adopt rules to implement temporary supplementary measures in accordance with GS Chapter 150B.
