H 1798. RESTORE STATE-FUNDED LME SERVICES. Filed 5/18/10. TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DIVISION OF MENTAL HEALTH, DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES, AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE SERVICES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES TO RESTORE STATE-FUNDED SERVICES PROVIDED THROUGH LOCAL MANAGEMENT ENTITIES, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE ON MENTAL HEALTH, DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES, AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE SERVICES.

Appropriates \$40 million for 2010-11 from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities, and Substance Abuse Services to increase funds for state-funded services provided through local management entities (LMEs). Requires that funds allocated to LMEs under this act (1) match the amount that state funds were reduced on a nonrecurring basis during the 2009-10 fiscal year for the individual LME and (2) are used only to restore state-funded services provided by the LME before budget reductions enacted in the 2009-10 fiscal year. Effective July 1, 2010.
