Adds new GS 115C-47.2, applicable to Moore County Board of Education only, for purpose indicated in title. Officers would be sworn, with all the powers of law enforcement officers generally. Their jurisdiction would extend to all property owned or leased by the board of education and adjacent public roads. Board could enter into agreement with any municipality to extend its officers' jurisdiction into the municipality's territory. In all other territory, officers' authority would be limited to investigations or arrests arising out of activities related to their duties and authority as employees of the board. Intro. by Boles.
