H 1893. WINSTON-SALEM FOX HUNTING. Filed 5/19/10. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Limits the open season for taking foxes to trapping with cage traps (was, with weapons and by trapping). Makes conforming changes to the title.

July 7, 2010

H 1893. W-S/ ASHE FOX TRAPPING/ GREENE HUNTING (NEW). Filed 5/19/10. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 2nd edition.

Amends SL 2007-51 regarding the trapping and sale of foxes in Ashe County. Provides that there is an open season for trapping foxes from November 1 (was, November 7) through February 28 (was, February 12) of each year. Deletes specifications regarding the use of leghold traps. Deletes the sunset provision on SL 2007-51 (was, expires on September 30, 2010).

Amends provisions regarding regulating hunting in Greene County by repealing Section 3 of SL 1975-219 (unlawful to hunt fox with firearms during the two week deer season) and Section 1 of SL 1987-132 (unlawful to hunt with a loaded firearm from or on a public road).

Amends Section 4 of SL 1985-471 (prohibits the discharge of firearms from public roads) to make the provisions applicable only to Nash County (was, applied to Nash and Greene Counties).

Amends the title to reflect the bill content.
