H 1903. NCIOM STUDIES/FUNDS. Filed 5/19/10. TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE NORTH CAROLINA INSTITUTE OF MEDICINE TO COMPLETE ITS CURRENT STUDIES AND TO ESTABLISH A TASK FORCE TO STUDY THE NEEDS OF YOUNG CHILDREN WITH MENTAL HEALTH PROBLEMS AND THEIR FAMILIES, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE ON MENTAL HEALTH, DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES, AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE SERVICES.

Appropriates \$250,000 in recurring funds for 2010-11 from the General Fund to the North Carolina Institute of Medicine (NCIOM) to complete Task Force studies authorized in the 2009 Appropriations Act. Appropriates \$150,000 for 2010-11 from the General Fund to the NCIOM for the purpose of convening a Task Force to study the needs of young children with mental health problems and their families. Directs the NCIOM to submit an interim report by January 15, 2012, to the Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on Mental Health Developmental Disabilities, and Substance Abuse Services and to issue a final report with findings, recommendations, and any proposed legislation to the 2013 General Assembly upon its convening.
