H 2084. STUDY HOUSING AND EMPLOYMENT INITIATIVES. Filed 7/6/10. DIRECTING THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION TO STUDY THE FEASIBILITY AND COST-EFFECTIVENESS OF ESTABLISHING A STATEWIDE SUPPORTIVE HOUSING INITIATIVE FOR INDIVIDUALS WITH MENTAL HEALTH, DEVELOPMENTAL, OR SUBSTANCE ABUSE DISABILITIES.

As title indicates. Requires that the study examine whether the type of initiative being studied could achieve nine specified goals with respect to individuals with mental health, developmental, or substance abuse disabilities, including the goals of fewer emergency room visits and hospital admissions, improved levels of functioning in the community, and decreased rates of homelessness. Requires that the Legislative Research Commission report its findings, which must address five specified issues, to the General Assembly by April 1, 2011.
